Invitation

On behalf of the Österreichischer Eischnelllauf Verband (ÖESV) and the Winter World Masters Organizing Committee (WWMG-OC) we have the honour and pleasure to invite you to participate in the

Winter World Masters Games 2020 Short Track Speed Skating January, 10 – 13, 2020 Innsbruck, AUSTRIA

to be held at the indoor Icerink "Olympiahalle - Olympiaworld Innsbruck", Olympiastraße 10, 6020, Innsbruck, AUSTRIA

The Winter World Masters Games 2020 (WWMG) are the biggest winter sports festival for 30+ year olds. More than 3000 athletes are expected to compete in 12 sports from January, 10th till 19th in and around Innsbruck.

General Regulations

The Competition will be held in accordance with the Regulations of the International Skating Union and the IMSSC Constitutions and Regulations 2019 - 2020.

Participation

A Competitor must be an individual member of an International Skating Union (ISU) Member, or a member of a club that is itself a member of an ISU Member. Competitors must register and pay themselves.

Teams per Member consisting of 4 skaters (female and/or men). In the relay event, a maximum of two skaters of a team can start in an age category lower than their age, but not higher. Skaters can only take part in one team.

Age categories may be combined dependent upon the number of entries in each age group.

Preliminary Program

The Short Track races will take between January, 10 until 12 2020. There will be three competition days. One day of official training is planned for Thursday, January 9th. This program is tentative and subject to change by the organizing committee. A detailed program will be published on www.innsbruck2020.com

Athlete Information Meeting (AIM)

Instead of team leaders meetings the Winter World Masters Games will schedule one or multiple Athlete-Information-Meetings. Each athlete is strongly advised to take part in this meeting. Time and place of the AIM will be announced.

Track Conditions & Rink Dimensions

The "Olympiahalle" Icerink has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 30×60 meters. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Short track speed skating 2018 Rule 280, paragraph 5 and the respective ISU Communications. The tracks are compliant with Rule 280, paragraph 1-4 and 6.

Conditions of Contest

The individual competition is a Single Distance Competition. All Final System and Knock out System are used for qualification. The first qualifying round of the distances will be based on the current season best time submitted by the participant/ skater at the entry. All subsequent rounds based on the intermediate distance classifications. The make up of races will be made according to Rule 296.

Relay Teams and Conditions of Contest

Open (Mixed Gender) Relay teams are composed of four skaters (either mixed or same gender) from the same country. Substitutes from the same country are allowed. Entries for the relay competition can be done in the race office.

Entries

Participants can register for the WWMG 2020 from 4th of February 2019 until the end of the registration period on 1 November 2019 by online registration at www.innsbruck2020.com/registration. Registration must be made personally by the respective Participant. Please keep in mind, that there is free cancellation for early-bird bookings till October, 1st 2019.

Number of total athletes for Short Track is limited to 200.

Registration Fee:

Entry fee: 180 EUR per participant. Payments have to be done by credit card via the WWMG-registration tool.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to the first three competitors/ teams of each age group.

Liability and Insurance

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the Österreichischer Eisschnelllauf Verband (ÖESV) and the Winter World Masters Organizing Committee (WWMG-OC) don't take responsibility or is liable with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the competition.

It is the participant's own responsibility to take out adequate and valid accident and health insurance and, if necessary, repatriation insurance for participation in the WWMG 2020. Further the participant is responsible to take out and maintain for the duration of participation, an adequate valid liability insurance policy for participation in the WWMG. It is pointed out, that the organiser will not take out any insurance in favour of the participant.

Anti-Doping

As directed by IMGA (International Masters Games Association) and in line with the WADA Code, the use of performance-enhancing drugs is strictly prohibited. Each participant must comply with and independently consent to the IMGA Anti-Doping Rules which can be found at https://imga.ch/en/events/#doping
